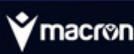

**Edinburgh Rugby centurion and Scotland internationalist WP Nel this week penned a new one-year deal that will see the tighthead prop remain in the Scottish capital for the 2023/24 season.**

The fan favourite will now enter his 12th season in Edinburgh – having joined from Cheetahs in 2012 – giving him the opportunity to add to his 186 appearances in the capital front row, a total only bettered by fellow club legend front-rowers Ross Ford (199) and Allan Jacobsen (273).

Nel is currently fifth on the club's all-time appearance list – behind Jacobsen, Chris Paterson (205), Ross Ford and Grant Gilchrist (188) – while his 268 club and representative rugby appearances in all competitions are the 12th most by a tighthead prop in the pro era.

Still operating at the pinnacle of the sport, Nel, 36, featured in four of Scotland's recent Guinness Six Nations matches – starting the Calcutta Cup victory at Twickenham – and will soon set his mind on a third Rugby World Cup with the national side.

The tighthead has also enjoyed good form at club level, most notably in an 80-minute display in January's Heineken Champions Cup triumph against Saracens, where he won a last-minute scrum penalty to seal the victory in front of a fervent home support.

The one-year extension is expected to be Nel's final season in an impressive career, which has so far seen the tighthead make 345 professional appearances, including 54 caps for Scotland.

Nel said: "I'm really happy to have signed a new deal with Edinburgh Rugby. It's a club that means so much to me and the city is home for me and my family. We love it here and plan to continue life here after rugby."

"My body still feels great, which was a massive factor in signing a new deal. I still feel like I can make an impact at the top level, so I want to do continue doing that for another season with a club that has backed me for over a decade of my career."

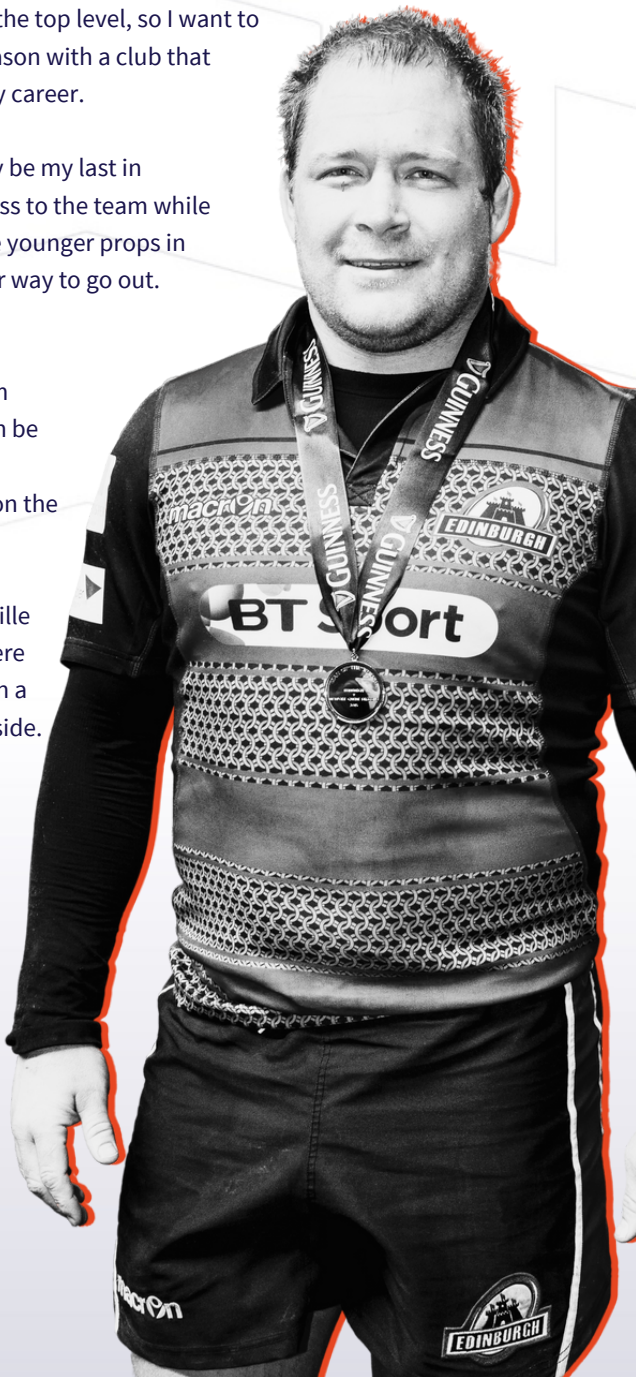
He continued: "Next year will probably be my last in professional rugby. If I can bring success to the team while providing leadership and advice to the younger props in the squad, then I can't think of a better way to go out."

"Rugby has given me so much in life. I might be one of the older guys but I'm still hugely competitive and know I can be one of the best in my position on any given day. It will be an honour to pull on the Edinburgh jersey for another season."

Nel began his rugby career at Durbanville Belville Rugby Club in Cape Town, where impressive performances saw him earn a place in the nearby Western Province side.

As a stand-out for Western Province in the 2008 Vodacom Cup, he was loaned to Boland Kavaliers to compete in the Currie Cup, where he was spotted, and then snapped up by Free State Cheetahs.

Nel stayed a Cheetahs for four years from his Super Rugby debut against Waratahs at the tail end of 2009. The tighthead's form then caught the eye of Edinburgh Rugby, who signed him on a three-year contract in the summer of 2012, where he has plied his trade ever since.





The front-row qualified to play for Scotland through residency in 2015, and made his debut for the national team against Italy in Turin, before playing a pivotal role throughout the subsequent Rugby World Cup 2015 campaign.

Nel surpassed the 100-appearance mark with Edinburgh against Leinster in September 2016 and from there his impressive form continued into the 2018/19 season, typified by a Man of the Match performance against Montpellier, which helped Edinburgh secure passage to the knockout stages of the Heineken Champions Cup.

After a second Rugby World Cup in Japan (2019) – where he continued to play a pivotal role in the Scottish pack – the tighthead was back to his best for his club as Edinburgh Rugby reached the Semi-Finals of the then Guinness PRO14 in 2020.

Nel then reached a landmark half-century of caps for Scotland in the 2022 Autumn Nation Series, coming off the bench against the All Blacks at BT Murrayfield.

Head Coach Mike Blair added: “WP [Nel] is a true Edinburgh legend and someone that inspires the players around him because of his commitment to representing the club and tenacity to be the best in his position.

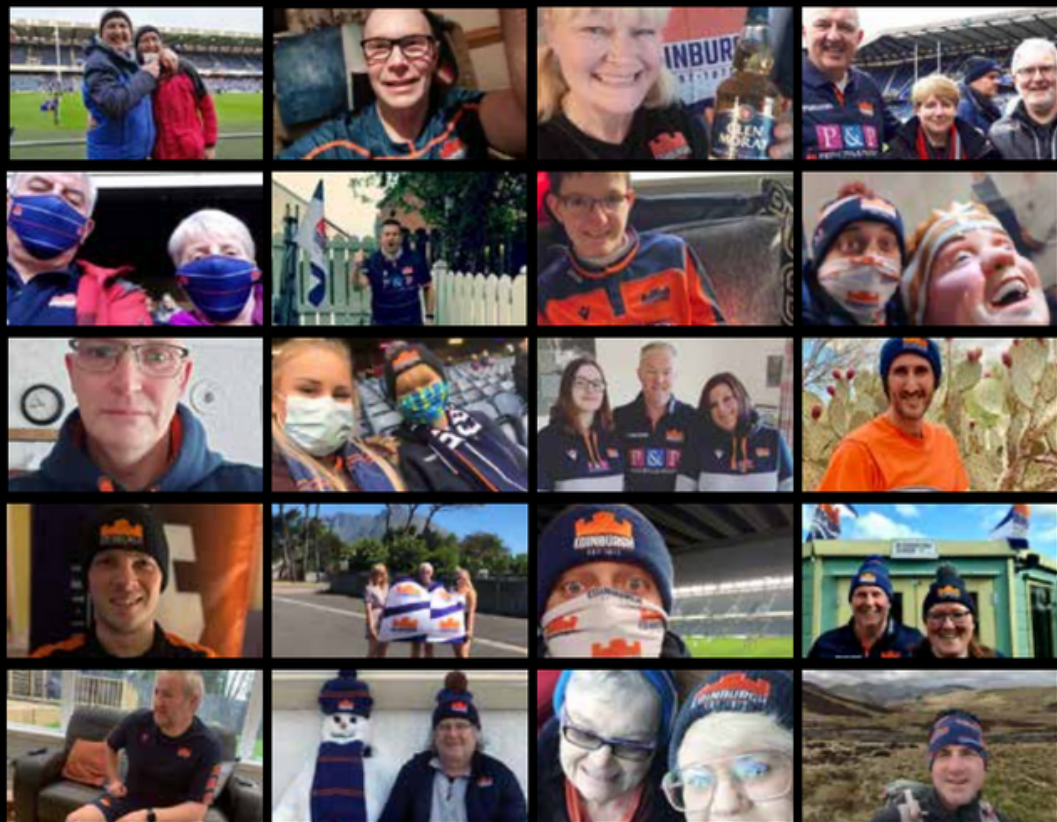
“He’s a different beast and that’s shown in his performances for both Edinburgh and Scotland throughout his career and again this season, where his energy levels and eagerness to make an impact have been through the roof.

“We’re truly delighted WP has chosen to sign a one-year extension with the club. He epitomises what it means to be an Edinburgh man and there’s no doubt he’ll be champing at the bit when the 23/24 season comes around.”

# PRESS PASS

## **ON THE DESIRE TO WIN THE CLUB'S FINAL HOME GAME OF THE SEASON**

"We've not played at home since the Leinster game, but we've got a lot of guys playing in this game on Saturday who won't have been involved then.

"Selection has been really interesting this week, we're trying to tick a number of boxes. We're trying to give guys opportunities who might be playing their last game for the club, trying to give guys opportunities who are playing for world cup places and give opportunities to guys who have been consistent in what they have given to the club.

"A home game is a great one to have, against the Ospreys they are a team who are full of internationals, probably had a similar-ish season to us in terms of doing

well in the Heineken Champions Cup but they haven't had the consistency in the URC stuff as well.

"They've got stuff to play for with the Welsh Shield and we've got something to play for with Fan Appreciation Night and as I said before, putting a team performance onto the pitch to help those individuals."

## **ON THE SENIOR PLAYERS LEAVING THE CLUB AND NEXT SEASON'S CLUB**

"It will be a similar number of players in the squad. I'm not having as much to do with the recruitment stuff at the moment.

"It's a funny market for players and actually holding back a little bit and keeping your powder dry – it's a buyer's market, it favours clubs at the moment.

I imagine there's still some stuff to come but that's where the situation is at the moment."

## ON STEVE DIAMOND

“He’s been watching, behind the scenes and seeing how things flow from a coaching point of view, from a players point of view and he’s getting a good understanding of where we’re at.

“He’s addressed the group two or three times but generally he’s been there to have an opinion. I ask him his opinion on things, he’ll come out with a couple of questions like, ‘why are you doing that?’ or, ‘would you do this?’ so he becomes part of the discussion.”

## ON THE FOSROC SUPER SERIES SPRINT AND YOUNGER PLAYERS STEPPING UP

“Yes, we’re definitely looking at younger players right now. So, the first game there with Heriot’s we had a bit of a blend of a team because we’ve still had two games left to go for our selection, we need guys to be up to speed.

“There’s a little bit of rust in us if you haven’t played for a while and we had a few guys who needed some game time.

“We had some senior guys, I think we had seven senior guys involved last week. We’ll have some senior guys involved this week.

“But it’s trying to get that balance of the young players coming through who haven’t had a huge amount of rugby either. So, getting them up to speed, giving them meaningful, competitive games. It’ll be important in the next couple of weeks.”

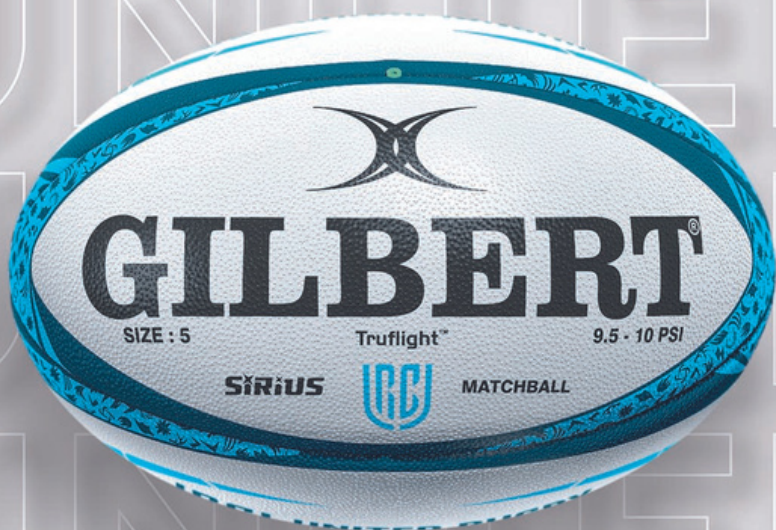

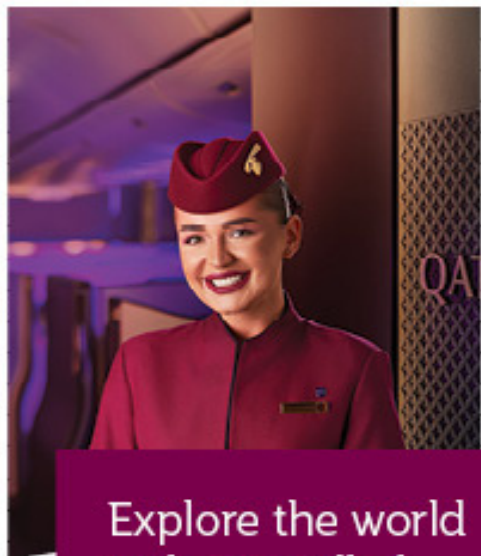

They sky greyed as the game got underway at Goldenacre and Edinburgh made fast work out the gate.

Seizing the opportunity of Heriot's Cam Jones' blind side, Edinburgh's Jamie Hodgson uses his strength to plant the ball down securing the first try of the game.

Heriot's were keen to show the guests they mean business as they pushed back against a strong Edinburgh side. After multiple phases of intense play Finn Douglas used his strength to get himself over the line and add another five points to Edinburgh's lead.

Edinburgh's Finn Douglas created a gap in the Heriot's line which allowed Glen Young to grab the ball and sprint over the whitewash dotting the ball over the line.

The guests at Goldenacre continue to dominate the scoreboard as Nathan Sweeney stretched over the line to get the fourth try of the game.

## SCOTTISH BUILDING SOCIETY PLAYER OF THE MONTH - MARCH

**Centre James Lang is today voted March's Scottish Building Society Player of the Month after an impressive showing in the capital midfield.**

“It’s not been a great few months for the club, but I’m hoping we can finish the season strong and put a good performance out there for the fans.”

“His selection of Cancer Research is a very fitting charity for our final POTM donation of the year.

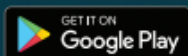
