





PIERRE | SCHOEMAN



As the floodlights hum over Hive Stadium this Friday night, the forecast suggests a classic Scottish winter evening: wet, windy and uncompromising.

For many, it's a night to stay indoors, but for Edinburgh Rugby's charismatic prop Pierre Schoeman, it is the perfect stage for a BKT United Rugby Championship (URC) showdown.

Facing his former side, the Vodacom Bulls, 'Schoey' knows exactly what is coming. The Pretoria outfit arrives with a reputation for brutal physicality and set-piece dominance, but the Scottish international believes the conditions – and the home crowd – will play right into Edinburgh's hands.

"I am excited about the Bulls this week," Schoeman says. "They are a tough outfit and pride themselves on their set-piece and physicality. It will be horrendous weather, and we love it. It is going to be bad. But I am looking forward to it."



The visit of the Bulls marks a pivotal moment in the URC season. With the calendar turned to 2026, Edinburgh are looking to transform their impressive European form – highlighted by home wins over Gloucester and Toulon – into a steady climb up the domestic ladder.

“In Europe, we are through. We take pride in the work we put in here,” Schoeman explains. “2026 is a new start. This game is the turning point in the season if you look at the URC log.

“Our main job is to do as well as we can in set-piece defence. In this game, the only currency is actions. You can say what you want in the media and the meetings, but you have to act. That is our only currency.”

While his focus is now firmly on Friday night, Schoeman returns to the squad refreshed after a unique period of downtime.



Eschewing traditional holiday hotspots, the prop chose to further immerse himself in his adopted homeland, heading north to the rugged landscapes of Glen Coe and the coastal waters of the Borders.

“It wasn't really a holiday, but it is nice to get downtime,” he says. “We love Scotland. At Glen Coe, we eat some good salmon, some good berries, and we swim in the Lochs. I do a bit of wild swimming and go for a few walks. We have friends in Eyemouth, so we do that down at Coldingham Bay. Open-water swimming is better; you get better scenery than an ice bath!”



The clash carries a personal edge for Schoeman. Opposite him will be lifelong friends like Wilco Louw and Marco van Staden; men he has shared scrums with since the age of 18.

“I want to stand tall, firm, toe-to-toe, and afterwards enjoy it,” Schoeman smiles. “It's like blood brothers. If a fight breaks out, you have to meet it, but afterwards, they are your friends. I am just Pierre Schoeman, Schoey, as I have always been. I never change.”

One of his closest connections remains Springbok fly-half Handre Pollard. The pair lived together in the Bulls' Under-19 house, a time Schoeman remembers fondly, largely for the battles in the kitchen.

“I am friends with Pauly (Pollard). We all lived in the house together. How was it living with him? There were a lot of steaks. You had to protect your steaks. The stakes were high!”

However, Schoeman is quick to point out that the comforts of their youth won't help the visitors once the whistle blows at the Hive.

“It is different for Pauly to kick the ball in the rain and the mud with bagpipes and drums going on in the background. We are ready for them.”

HIVE STADIUM MUST REMAIN A FORTRESS



SEAN EVERITT

Head Coach Sean Everitt is determined to maintain Edinburgh Rugby's unblemished Hive Stadium home record this Friday night, insisting the squad is motivated to keep it a "fortress" when the Vodacom Bulls arrive for a massive BKT United Rugby Championship encounter.

Having won every game played at the ground so far this season, Everitt is eager for his side to rebound from last week's European away loss to Bath and protect their home turf.

"We've had good performances at home," Everitt said. "At Hive Stadium, we haven't been beaten yet and we know we want to make this a fortress.

"We played our best rugby and we played well against Toulon, but those games are gone now. Obviously, what happened on Friday night [against Bath] we're not proud of as a rugby club, so we're looking to make amends."

PREVIEW

Standing in their way is a formidable Vodacom Bulls side that Everitt describes as a “dangerous beast.”

While the South African side has seen coaching changes recently, Everitt knows exactly what to expect from a team that combines traditional physicality with an evolving offensive game.

“It’s a difficult team to analyse at the moment because they’ve had a change in the coaching staff and they’ve been trying to grow their attack with a new attack coach,” Everitt explained.

“They’ll come here with a different energy. They’ve got big players and they enjoy their direct rugby. What we do know is that we need to be accurate because they do pose threats for us at set-piece time as well as at the breakdown.”

The challenge is further heightened by the return of Handre Pollard, the double World Cup-winning fly-half whom Everitt has watched since his schoolboy days.

“They’ve added Handre Pollard to their armoury and he’s a world-class 10 as we know,” said Everitt.



“I watched Handre come through school level and he was a different class at that point. As a schoolboy, he played for the South African under-20 team; he showed a lot of potential there and he certainly reached that. I’m quite sure he will play on Friday night.”

Regarding the Bulls’ selection, Everitt expects a full-strength visiting side after they successfully rotated their squad during their recent trip to Pau.

“They came up into Europe with 30 of the best players that they could pick. They didn’t pick their best team against Pau on Friday night, obviously resting players after the Bristol defeat to be fresh for us in this game. I presume that they’ll go for full strength as they look to climb the ladder.”





Brown is one of two changes to the capital starting fifteen, with tighthead Faye Sutherland also getting the nod from the first whistle.

Claire Cruikshank opts for an unchanged back-three, with electric trio of full-back Nicole Marlow and wingers Hannah Walker and Cleron Bell starting for the fourth game on the bounce.

Outside-centre Brown's return to the starting side sees Rachel Philipps shift to the twelve jersey, alongside ever-present half-back partnership of Emily Love and Hannah Ramsay.

Sutherland is the sole change in the pack, starting in the front-row with loosehead Alison Wilson and hooker Aila Ronald.

Adelle Ferrie and Natasha Logan continue to start together at lock, while Alex Stewart (openside flanker), Catriona Moody (blindside), and Kay Lusby (number-eight) complete the pack.

THIRTEEN SELECTED FOR SCOTLAND AND SCOTLAND A SQUADS

Edinburgh Rugby is proud to confirm that nine players have been named in Gregor Townsend's 40-man Scotland squad for the upcoming 2026 Guinness Men's Six Nations, while a further four club representatives have been selected for the Scotland A training squad.

The senior selection ahead of the tournament opener against Italy in Rome on Saturday 7 February features an exciting blend of club icons and emerging talent, led by the inclusion of up-and-coming back-row duo Freddy Douglas and Liam McConnell, who have both been rewarded for their terrific starts to the campaign.

They join a powerful forward contingent featuring Ewan Ashman, Scotland's leading try-scoring forward, and tighthead D'arcy Rae, who is set to make his return from injury against Vodacom Bulls this weekend.



Club captain Magnus Bradbury also gets the nod after a dominant start to the year, alongside the experienced Grant Gilchrist, who continues his return to full fitness, and ever-present prop Pierre Schoeman.

The backline will once again benefit from the clinical finishing of Scotland's two leading all-time try-scorers, Duhan van der Merwe and Darcy Graham, both of whom are named in the squad for the upcoming Championship.

In addition to the senior honours, the club is well-represented in the Scotland A training squad ahead of their match against an Italy XV at Stadio Centro D'Italia, Manlio Scopigno, on Friday 6 February.

This fixture, which kicks off at 6.30pm local time, is a key pillar of the new performance pathway plans, identifying A matches as a vital way to develop players in a high-level environment before they make the step up to the full national squad.



Harry Paterson is named in the squad following an impressive return from injury against Bath last weekend, joined by hooker Harri Morris, who was capped in the recent Autumn Nations Series.

The selection also includes uncapped props Ollie Blyth-Lafferty and James Whitcombe, marking a significant step in their professional development. The Scotland A side, which will also incorporate players from the wider senior squad, will be led by Glasgow Warriors' Nigel Carolan as Head Coach, supported by assistant coaches Scott Forrest and Edinburgh Rugby's own Stevie Lawrie.
